

Prior to arrival

Enquiries and bookings can be made by telephone or email. Directions to Glendown Farm Camping Park can be found on our website or can be posted on request. Please ask if you require bigger font for your postal correspondence.

The Camping Park is located in the South of the Island, 0.4miles (0.64km) from Port St Mary and 0.9miles (1.45km) from Port Erin, on a quiet country road that links the two villages.

The camping area is over 1.4 acres and has a permanent utility block, consisting of a kitchen/dining area and ladies, gents and disabled/baby changing toilets and showers. There is a level concrete path to the utility block with doors suitable for wheel chair access.

There are shepherds' huts, which have electric lighting/plugs and have a double bottom bunk and a single top bunk. There is also a sofa suitable for sleeping accommodation for a child. Regrettably, the shepherds' huts are not suitable for wheel chair users.

Additional Information

There is a smoke detector in the kitchen area which, when triggered will give a continuous bell. The Utility Block fire exits are the main kitchen door and the main door of the toilet area.

There are two fire assembly points; the first situated in the centre of the camping area and the second in the picnic area.

There is a manual fire alarm bell at each fire assembly point.
