

Accessibility Statement For Peel Camping Park

Description of Accommodation and Facilities

Peel camping park caters for tents and motorhomes. The site is located within 50 metres of Peel Swimming Pool which offers café and recreational swimming facilities. The park has hard standing and grass pitches. Electric hook-ups, waste bins, water taps and chemical waste disposal facilities are available in the campsite grounds. The main campsite office, toilets, showers, dish washing, laundry and television room is located in a building adjacent to the hard standing area at the entrance to the camping park. The site is flat and has tarmac hard standing areas. The tarmac paths and electricity hook-ups are all located around the camping park building. The camping park is manned part time in the afternoons and early evenings. Advanced telephone, email or written bookings are accepted along with payment on arrival. The camping park is closed during the winter and autumn periods.

Accessibility

The facilities have the following disabled adaptations to ensure access for the general public.

Information on fees and services are accessible on the internet or through contacting the Commissioners' Offices by telephone or visiting in person during normal office working hours;

Bookings are accessible by email, telephone, in person or by letter;

Signage directing traffic to the camping park and to the facilities once in the camping park uses internationally recognised symbols;

Level accesses are provided to the toilets, office, laundry, dish washing, showers, television room and off site to the public highway footways including Peel Swimming Pool/Café facilities;

Disabled toilet and shower facilities are present in the main camping park building;

Low level access is provided for dish washing, laundry, potable water taps and chemical disposal facility;

Reserved hard standing parking and grass pitches are available neighbouring the main camping park building to ensure these facilities are conveniently located within 20 metres of the pitches;

Smooth and level tarmac and concrete paths link pitches to the camping park building, the adjoining public highway footways and conveniently located bus stop; and

A Warden is present in the afternoons and early evenings to assist users of the camping park and to welcome arrivals from the ferry.

Restrictions

All pitches in camping park particularly those in the grassed areas do not have smooth tarmac path access. The Commissioners' mitigate this by planning reservation of the convenient pitches neighbouring the camping park facilities and through having a level and well drained grassed pitching area.

The camping park does not have specific directional signage/aids for unaccompanied severely visually impaired members of the public. However, the camping park solely provides motorhome and tent pitches which reduces the likelihood of unaccompanied severely visually impaired persons seeking to visit the facilities without making an appointment with the Warden prior to their stay.
