“TREES FOR LIFE” WALK CONRHENNY PLANTATION

ROUTE

- Park in the car park located just off the Creg ny Baa Back Road. From here there are two route options:
- For the extended route follow the GREEN signs around the outskirts of the plantation before heading back to the Children’s Wood.
- For the shorter, more accessible route follow the YELLOW signs into the plantation and around the Children’s Wood before arriving back at the car park.

ACTIVITIES

- Can you identify the different trees? Oak, Aspen, Birch, Alder and Rowan. These were planted by school children as part of the ‘Trees for Life’ initiative. Since 2008 around 5,000 trees have been planted in the Children’s Wood.
- Can you see the Wind Farm?
- Can you see the Reservoir?
- Can you see Snaefell mountain?
- Nature Rubbing – why don’t you bring a pencil and some paper for your walk? Place the paper against a tree, a leaf, an interesting stone or seed and gently rub the side of the pencil on the paper until the pattern shows through. Do this for a few different items and compare the different textures.
