Accessibility Statement Curlew Cottage 34 Mill Street Castletown IM9 1AG

At a glance

Regrettably we are unable to accommodate full time wheel chair users as there are narrow doorways in the cottage and the bedroom, shower and bath facilities are located on the first floor, which is only accessible by a narrow staircase with 12 quite steep steps.

Introduction

The cottage is on a well maintained street and pavement is even and well lit at night by street lights. The cottage name is clearly visible on the front of the cottage. There is no dropped pavement kerb into the cottage however there is a small rise when entering the property. The cottage sleeps two adults with a double bed on the first floor with en-suite bathroom. This has a bath and separate shower cubical washbasin, and toilet. There are no disabled hand rails or seat and no toilet seat raisers. Access to the first floor is via a flight of stairs, which are narrow and quite steep with handrail. The living/dining room is on the ground floor with digital television with remote control and subtitles for the hearing impaired. There is a small fully fitted kitchen to the rear with one step down. Outside the garden and patio area is accessible by three steep stone steps.

Future Plans

Unfortunately as Curlew Cottage is a traditional Manx stone cottage in a terraced row within a conservation area we are unable to make any improvements for accessibility.
