Accessibility Statement

Sulby Community Hall, Clenagh Road, Sulby, Lezayre

The Sulby Community Hall is mainly used by the Community for children's parties, fundraising events, club meetings, badminton training, Tai Chi exercise and Church groups.

The hall has level access from its large rear car park.

Our facilities are offered as a hostel which is mainly used by visiting bikers for the Isle of Man TT and the Manx Grand Prix. It is also used by the local Guiding community.

We call our facilities "indoor camping" as we expect our guests to bring their own sleeping equipment such as a lilo and a sleeping bag. There is a ramp from our foyer area down into our large hall, which when in use as a hostel would be the sleeping/living area for our users.

Our kitchen is fully equipped with all the necessary items needed for making drinks, preparing and cooking meals.

We do have disabled toilet facilities with all the necessary fittings and all doorways can accommodate the width of a standard wheelchair. If you are visiting our hall and using it as a hostel, the facilities are not set up for the sole use of a disabled visitor, but if you were visiting along with others, then we feel our facilities with assistance to the disabled user could be made suitable.
