JACKSON HOUSE ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT

LOCATION King William's College is situated in Castletown, the south of the Isle of Man. It is on the A5 road to Douglas. Jackson House is a satellite building, situated on the left hand side of the main school attached to Music School. Visitors are required to use the main car park during their stay. The building is on 1 level and has en-suite bedrooms. The building does have limited disabled access, please contact us for further details.

ENTRANCE Access to the building is only through the front door which has a code pad. The code will be given prior to arrival or you will be met by one of the Porters. The entrance would accommodate wheelchair access and all rooms and facilities are on the Ground floor.

GROUND FLOOR There is a modern kitchen and lounge on this floor together with 3 twin rooms and 6 bunk rooms (4 bunk beds) which are all en-suite, there are 'walk-in' showers in each room so there is limited disabled access.

Porters are on call and will be available should assistance be required, guests will be met on arrival and given contact details and instructions regarding emergency procedures.

Jackson House is as our Medical Centre so is only available during the holiday periods.

As we are a boarding school child protection and safeguarding is extremely important. Guests may be required to wear visitor lanyards whilst on school grounds. Catering can only be offered to groups of 20 or more.

Unfortunately we do not allow pets, should you wish to bring your assistance dog please contact us to discuss your requirements.
