LEISURELY

Distance:	7.22 miles
Start & Finish:	Castletown Station (<i>Outdoor Leisure Map Ref: 269 680</i>)
By Steam Railway:	Take the steam train starting from Douglas or Port Erin, alight at Castletown Station.
By Bus:	Services 1, 1A, 2, 10, 10A, 11, 11A, 12, 12A connect Douglas or Port Erin with Castletown. Services 8 & 8A connect Castletown with Foxdale and Peel.

Facilities (subject to opening hours)

Castletown:	Public toilets, public houses, restaurants, cafés, general stores
Derbyhaven:	Café

Route

1. Leave Castletown Station, cross the main road (A5) and walk down the road directly in-front of you.
2. Take the footpath next to the Coastguard Station, cross the road and turn left. You are now walking alongside Castletown beach.
3. At the parking area on the beach take the shingle footpath lying between the shore and the golf-course.
4. When you reach a lane, turn right heading towards Langness Point and the lighthouse.
5. There are numerous footpaths and tracks to meander along, enjoying the coastal views and wildlife.
6. Return by walking on the eastern side of the peninsular and golf-course towards St. Michael's Island. Turn left at the clubhouse to explore St. Michael's Island (also known locally as Fort Island).
7. Return by walking across the slipway and follow the road around Derbyhaven until you reach the slipway.
8. Turn right, walking alongside the airport perimeter, returning to Castletown Station.



Points of Interest

Castletown: Nautical Museum, Old House of Keys, Old Grammar School, Castle Rushen

Langness: Hango Hill, the Herring Tower

St Michael's Island: Derby Fort, Chapel remains
