

## MANX GRAND PRIX MOTORCYCLE RACES 2010

### ROADS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that the Department of Infrastructure has made an Order called the Manx Grand Prix Motorcycle Road Races Order 2010 which makes provision for the roads, known as the TT Course, to be closed to the public for the 2010 Manx Grand Prix Motorcycle Practices, Races and Parades as follows :-

#### 1. ROADS CLOSED FOR PRACTICES, PARADES AND RACES

#### 2. DELAYED RACES

In the event of adverse weather conditions etc the start of any race including a Parade may be delayed.

**If delays occur on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday and it is necessary to continue racing into the evening, the Course will re-opened to traffic not later than 5.00 pm, closing again at 6.00 pm for racing.**

**3. NOTIFICATION OF DELAYED AND POSTPONED CLOSURES WILL BE GIVEN IN THE NEWS BULLETINS ON LOCAL RADIO.**

**4. PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED AREAS**

Spectators are reminded that there is no access to prohibited and restricted areas during road closures (as clearly marked by signs and tapes).

**5. CROSSING PLACES**

During the practice and race periods no person or vehicle may pass any barriers on to the Course. Where a Police Officer is present the following pedestrian and vehicle crossing places are authorised between races on race days:-

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Douglas, Ballaquayle Road and Ballanard Road</li><li>• Douglas, Stoney Road and Tromode Road</li><li>• A1, Douglas and Braddan, between road closure barriers on Peel Road adjacent to the Fire Station, and Strang Road, Union Mills</li><li>• A1, Crosby Old Church, Eyreton Road and Ballavitchel Road</li><li>• A3, Barregarrow crossroads, Michael</li><li>• A3, Kirk Michael, Douglas Road Corner and the entrance to Faaie-ny-Cabbal</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A3, Station Road and Glen Road, Ballaugh</li><li>• A3, Sulby Glen crossroads, Lezayre</li><li>• Ramsey, Albert Square and Princes Road</li><li>• Ramsey, Lheaney Road and Barrule Park</li><li>• A18, Onchan and Douglas, Signpost Corner and Bedstead Corner</li><li>• Onchan and Douglas, Governor’s Road, Victoria Road and Second Avenue on Glencrutchery Road.</li></ul>

**6. ACCESS ROAD TO THE INSIDE OF THE COURSE**

Vehicular access to the inside of the course, and for Nobles Hospital, is via the A5 New Castletown Road near the junction with the Quarterbridge Roundabout. The Access Road is narrow with passing places and traffic is controlled.

**7.** The Course will be re-opened for traffic by official motor vehicles displaying a notice “Roads Open” proceeding along the Course upon the completion of the Practices and Races, and by the passing of such vehicle the part of the Course so passed is open for traffic.

**8.** A copy of the MGP Order and ancillary orders may be inspected at any Police Station or at the undermentioned address. Offences against the Act or the Order render the offender liable to a penalty not exceeding £2,500.

This notice gives general guidance only and should not be treated as an authoritative statement of the law.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

**WHEN OPEN TO NORMAL TRAFFIC THE MOUNTAIN ROAD WILL BE 2 WAY. THERE IS NO ONE WAY SYSTEM IN OPERATION FOR THE MANX GRAND PRIX**
