MORNING: MANX MUSEUM

THE MANX MUSEUM TELLS THE STORY OF THE ISLE OF MAN THROUGH ITS CELTIC, VIKING, MARITIME AND TT HERITAGE. EXHIBITS INCLUDE ARCHAEOLOGY, ARTWORK, NATURAL HISTORY AND FILM, OFFERING A COMPREHENSIVE INTRODUCTION TO THE ISLAND'S CULTURE AND HISTORY.

RUNNING ALONG DOUGLAS PROMENADE, THE HISTORIC HORSE TRAMWAY HAS BEEN CARRYING PASSENGERS SINCE 1876. THE TRADITIONAL HORSE-DRAWN TRAMS OFFER A UNIQUE WAY TO EXPERIENCE THE CAPITAL'S SEAFRONT AND VICTORIAN HERITAGE.

AFTERNOON: OKELL'S BREWERY TOUR

ONE OF THE ISLAND'S MOST WELL-KNOWN BREWERIES, OKELLS HAS BEEN PRODUCING BEER ON THE ISLE OF MAN SINCE 1850.
