



GROUP ITINERARY: NORTH

MORNING: SNAEFELL MOUNTAIN RAILWAY

THE SNAEFELL MOUNTAIN RAILWAY CLIMBS FROM LAXEY TO THE SUMMIT OF THE ISLE OF MAN'S ONLY MOUNTAIN, REACHING OVER 2,000 FEET ABOVE SEA LEVEL. THE JOURNEY OFFERS PANORAMIC VIEWS ACROSS THE ISLAND AND, ON CLEAR DAYS, VIEWS OF ENGLAND, IRELAND, SCOTLAND AND WALES.

MORNING: THE GREAT LAXEY WHEEL

KNOWN LOCALLY AS "LADY ISABEL", THE GREAT LAXEY WHEEL IS THE LARGEST WORKING WATERWHEEL IN THE WORLD. BUILT IN 1854 TO PUMP WATER FROM THE NEARBY MINES, IT REMAINS ONE OF THE ISLE OF MAN'S MOST ICONIC LANDMARKS.

LUNCH: VICTORY CAFE OR MILNTOWN

GROUPS CAN ENJOY LUNCH AT EITHER MILNTOWN, SET WITHIN THE GROUNDS OF A HISTORIC ESTATE AND GARDENS, OR THE VICTORY CAFE, LOCATED ON THE TT MOUNTAIN COURSE AND POPULAR FOR ITS MOTORSPORT CONNECTIONS AND SCENIC VIEWS.

AFTERNOON: ISLE OF MAN MOTOR MUSEUM

THE ISLE OF MAN MOTOR MUSEUM FEATURES AN IMPRESSIVE COLLECTION OF CLASSIC CARS, MOTORCYCLES AND AUTOMOBILIA, INCLUDING TT AND MOTORSPORT EXHIBITS. THE MUSEUM CELEBRATES THE ISLAND'S LONG-STANDING CONNECTION WITH TRANSPORT AND RACING HISTORY.

AFTERNOON: FYNODEREE DISTILLERY

INSPIRED BY MANX FOLKLORE AND NATURAL INGREDIENTS, FYNODEREE DISTILLERY PRODUCES AWARD-WINNING SPIRITS INCLUDING GIN, RUM AND VODKA. VISITORS CAN ENJOY TOURS AND TASTINGS WHILE LEARNING ABOUT THE STORIES AND BOTANICALS BEHIND THE BRAND.

AFTERNOON: MANX ELECTRIC RAILWAY
