Anyone who rides or drives an off road motorbike, ATV or 4x4 anywhere other than a designated byway or Greenway Road on the DEFA owned uplands will be in contravention of Section 28 of the Road Traffic Act and the Forestry Act 1984 and may be prosecuted. Additionally, members of the Auto Cycle Union are at risk of receiving event sanctions if they are found to be in contravention of either of the above acts.
