



GROUP ITINERARY: SOUTH

MORNING: ISLE OF MAN STEAM RAILWAY

TRAVELLING THROUGH ROLLING COUNTRYSIDE FROM DOUGLAS TO PORT ERIN, THE HOUR JOURNEY OFFERS A NOSTALGIC GLIMPSE INTO THE ISLAND'S VICTORIAN HERITAGE AND SCENIC SOUTHERN LANDSCAPES.

MORNING: ISLE OF MAN STEAM RAILWAY MUSEUM

LOCATED BESIDE PORT ERIN STATION, THE MUSEUM SHOWCASES THE HISTORY OF THE ISLAND'S RAILWAYS. A BRIEF BUT WORTHWHILE STOP FOR HERITAGE ENTHUSIASTS.

MORNING: CREGNEASH

A LIVING VILLAGE PRESERVING TRADITIONAL MANX CROFTING LIFE FROM THE 19TH CENTURY. VISITORS CAN EXPLORE THATCHED COTTAGES, MEET RARE LOAGHTAN SHEEP AND EXPERIENCE TRADITIONAL CRAFTS.

LUNCH: THE SOUND CAFE

SET BESIDE DRAMATIC COASTAL SCENERY OVERLOOKING THE CALF OF MAN, THE SOUND CAFÉ IS A POPULAR STOP WITH SPECTACULAR VIEWS. THE SURROUNDING AREA IS ALSO ONE OF THE ISLAND'S BEST LOCATIONS FOR WILDLIFE SPOTTING, INCLUDING SEALS AND SEABIRDS.

AFTERNOON: CASTLE RUSHEN

ONE OF THE BEST-PRESERVED MEDIEVAL CASTLES IN EUROPE, CASTLE RUSHEN DOMINATES THE HISTORIC TOWN OF CASTLETOWN. VISITORS CAN EXPLORE ITS TOWERS, CHAMBERS AND EXHIBITIONS WHICH TELL THE STORY OF IT'S BRUTAL PAST.

AFTERNOON: OLD HOUSE OF KEYS / THE NAUTICAL MUSEUM

THE OLD HOUSE OF KEYS OFFERS AN INSIGHT INTO THE ISLAND'S HISTORIC PARLIAMENT, WHICH IS THE OLDEST CONTINUOUS PARLIAMENT IN THE WORLD. NEARBY, THE NAUTICAL MUSEUM EXPLORES CASTLETOWN'S MARITIME PAST, INCLUDING THE STORY OF LOCAL YACHTSMAN AND INVENTOR GEORGE QUAYLE.
