- ➤ The following criteria apply to tourism accommodation businesses wishing to take part in the Bikers Welcome Scheme:
- Reassuring customers that they are more than welcome, even with bulky leathers and boots
- Provide an area for hanging leathers and storing helmets
- Be flexible meals/snacks available all day. Consider extended opening hours during TT and Festival of Motorcycling.
- Good selection of soft drinks available at reasonable cost
- Provision of safe parking for motorbikes (hard standing, off-road car park preferable)
- Access to Road map of the Isle of Man
- Information on attractions and details of the local Tourist Information Centre
- Information on local petrol stations and opening times.
- Knowledge of TT/ Festival of Motorcycling information, or literature provided (can be ordered from DED)
- Weather information
- Up to date information on the website and social media about opening hours and last service times
- Staff training in what to expect when bikers visit
