Irish Visitor Insights

In September 2020 Visit Isle of Man commissioned a third party research agency to perform a piece of visitor research to determine the impact COVID-19 has had on the travel market in the UK and Ireland.

The Agency's main objectives were to:

- · Identify the level of willingness to travel following the outbreak of COVID-19
- · Measure the level of awareness of the Isle of Man as a holiday destination
- Understand the typical traveller's 'customer journey' from the initial research and planning stages, through to booking a holiday or short break
- · Identify what travellers perceive as 'barriers' to choosing the Isle of Man as a holiday destination
- · Identify potential acccommodation and product development opportunities

302 of nationally representative Irish respondents aged 18+ took part in the survey. Respondents were screened based on a willingness to:

-go on holiday only within the British Isles in 2021

-go on holiday both inside and outside the British Isles in 2021

This document provides an overview of these findings.




Main takeaways - Ireland

- Awareness is stronger than expected with 70% of respondents citing they were aware of the Isle of Man as a holiday destination. This was also
 highlighted in particular in standing against other Islands the Isle of Man had a 51% awareness count, with the Channel Islands at 38%.
- Consideration of the Isle of Man as a future short break holiday destination was higher amongst the younger audiences, with 54% of 31-45 year olds
 and 54% of 18-30 year olds citing they would like to visit.
- There's a big opportunity for us to capture new markets in 2021-22 as people are considering holidaying at home as a result of the pandemic, before
 they start heading further afield, with 36% of respondents stating they will choose to holiday both inside and outside the British Isles in 2021, increasing
 to 41% in 2022. The Isle of Man can capitalise on the desire for 'countryside and rural holiday' destinations for these markets.
- · When looking to book a holiday or short break, top sources used to gather information, evaluate information and book include:
 - TV commercials
 - Online/digital sources (online advertising and Online Travel Agents and booking websites)
 - Reviews (online and peers)
- · 'Countryside' and 'Traditional Seaside' are the most sought after holiday and short break locations.
- Destinations with a low COVID-19 risk and offering 'book with confidence' messaging are the most important factors when considering a holiday or short break in 2021. 83% stated a low risk to COVID-19 was the greatest priority when choosing a holiday destination.
- 38% of those who are thinking about a British Isles holiday or short break will plan 1 to 3 months in advance.
- · People taking longer holidays, prefer self-catering.
- Couples prefer B&Bs, families prefer camping.



Most people are aware of the Isle of Man as a holiday destination


Which of the following short break and holiday destinations in the British Isles, if any, are you aware of? - Isle of Man

Which of the following short break and holiday destinations on the British Isles, would you consider visiting in the future?


UK adults 18+ who plan to go on holiday in the British isles in 2021 - Top 2 boxes

Which of the following short break and holiday destinations on the British Isles, would you consider visiting in the future? - Isle of Man




The cost of travel is the main barrier to booking a trip to the Isle of Man (outside of COVID-19 related issues)

When thinking about 2021 holidays and short breaks, what would prevent you from booking a trip to the Isle of Man?




Intention to travel only inside the British Isles will decrease

When thinking about holidays and short breaks you want to take in the future, which of the following statements best applies?




Over half of people favour the countryside - this is an opportunity for the Isle of Man

When thinking about holidays and short breaks you want to take in 2021 in the British Isles, which of the following destinations do you favour?




Those who go on holiday inside the British Isles plan 1 to 3 months in advance

When thinking about holidays and short breaks you want to take in 2021, how far in advance will you... - Review Options / Plan?




Those who go on holiday inside the British Isles <u>book</u> 1 to 3 months in advance

When thinking about holidays and short breaks you want to take in 2021, how far in advance will you... - Book travel?




Most people gather info through TV and digital advertising

When thinking about booking holidays and short breaks in 2021, which of the following will help you when gathering information?




Most people evaluate their choice through online websites

Most people **book** through booking websites


When thinking about booking holidays and short breaks in 2021, which of the following will help you when booking your chosen holiday/short break?





Low Covid-19 risk is the most important consideration




