Pre- Arrival: You can learn more about us, or book, via **Visit Isle of Man**, or Airbnb. You'll find more images, and information, on our Facebook page too, where you can also book directly.

Getting here: We're easy to find, just pop our IM9 1NX postcode into your Sat Nav. For step-by-step instructions, feel free to reach out via Messenger, or text 07624 567838, we're happy to guide you. We're also handily located for public transport. Bus Vannin services to Port Erin and Douglas (the 1, 2 or 12) usually run every 20 minutes. They stop close to the ferry, and by the airport door. Or, if you love heritage transport, why not enjoy the Steam Railway? We are located a few minutes, and a level walk, away from Castletown Market Square - and are even closer to the sea. A granite 'Captain's Quarters' sign, attached to a large rose bed, will indicate you have arrived.

Parking: Our off-road parking can accommodate two cars or six motorcycles. The (soon to be resurfaced) drive is two inches above the neighbouring footpath, and the drive has a very slight incline.

Entering the property: In the evening, sensors will light the two broad steps which lead up into the property. You will have a key for the Front Door which pushes open, as do the doors into the Games/Dining Room. You'll also have a key to your room, which has a lever handle. The Boot Room offers bench seating, the Games/Dining Room seats six, and the Breakfast Bar offers two tall stools.

Getting around: The three Guest Rooms are all located on the Ground Floor, which is level throughout. One steep step from the Kitchen, Aft or Midships rooms leads down to the terrace. We provide a brief tour of the facilities on your arrival.

Bathroom Facilities: The Fore and Midships ensuite bathrooms offer shallow shower trays, while the Aft bathroom features a bath/shower combination. All toilets are comfort height. The bathrooms have lever handles, as does the downstairs WC.

Other: The property is fossil-fuel free; Solar PV panels provide most of our electricity, infra-red panels provide heating, and hot water is delivered via our Solar Thermal system.

The Boot Room offers somewhere to leave biking boots or muddy footwear. The Storage Locker will relieve you of bulky coats and suitcases. Our Map Room/Hallway is where you'll find something to read; local history, folk tales, places to visit - or biker biographies, if racing is your thing. Guests are encouraged to enjoy the Games Room, which includes a pool table. You'll have a shelf in the fridge and another in the pantry, to store your groceries. Your bedroom includes complimentary tea making facilities, and a stocked mini fridge. If vinyl is your passion, take advantage of your record player – there are plenty of tunes to choose from! Though the Aft and Midships rooms offer direct access to the Terrace, everyone is welcome to enjoy our outside space. We're working to improve it, but our mini putting green is ready for use!

Please note: Captain's Quarters is an adults-only facility. Regrettably, our premises are not suitable for wheelchair users, due to the stepped access. As there is a much beloved Manx Cat on the premises, we do not accept pets, and are unsuitable for anyone with animal allergies.

Price Promise: Our rates never increase – our Room Only services remain a reasonable £100 per evening, whether the room is occupied by one person, or two. Pick your own fruit when our trees are in season, or, for an additional £12.50 pp, take advantage of the full breakfast we're happy to cook for you. With 24 hours notice, this can also include Vegetarian or Gluten-Free options. With the same notice, and an additional £25, you'll soon be able to book exclusive use of our two-person hot tub for an evening too.
