

Accessibility Statement – Ballacottier Campsite

The campsite is situated one and a half miles away from public transport; we can phone a taxi upon request.

Ideal if arriving for the TT or Festival of Motorcycling, as we are situated half a mile away from Hillberry Corner on the outside of the TT course.

We do accept pets including service dogs.

Unfortunately we are unable to accept full time wheelchair users due to the door widths being of a standard width.

Should our fields become very wet due to prolonged heavy rain, then we have hardstanding to the front and side of the house, also along the tree lined drive which is suitable to put vehicles.

Mobile phones with charger units may be brought to the house to be powered up

We have on display 3 classic racing bikes from the 1950's and 1960's, plus photographs of the same era

There are 3 steps leading to each of the ladies and gents showers

There are 2 steps to one gents toilet

There is 1 step to the wash room and 1 step to the rest room

The original older toilets – used as an overflow for very busy periods (TT), have a level entry access and a very small step to the 2 showers

New unit, currently under construction (which has ladies toilets, gents toilets, a unisex shower and a kitchen) due to be finished by mid-April (Easter) will have a ramp attached to the outside

We have wonderful country views, plus there are cycle tracks and countryside walks within the area.
