Accessibility statement for Edd Gollan Geayee

Edd Gollan Geayee is a converted barn, originally constructed in 1891. Ample parking is available immediately outside the property with good lighting, including PIRs which illuminate with movement.

It is over 2 floors with the bedrooms and bathroom downstairs and the kitchen and living area upstairs with access via a spiral staircase. It is fully carpeted except for the kitchen area, which has hard flooring.

There is one step downstairs, as you enter the double room. The passageway/hall is narrow.

The bathroom is compact with a shower situated over the bath. No handrails are available.

Service dogs are accepted.

There is no hearing loop system however there are no immediate neighbors, excepting ourselves, so no problem with TV or radio volume.

The property is regretfully not suitable for full time wheelchair users due to the structure and design of the building.
