Ballamenagh Accessibility Statement

Ballamenagh is situated on the A3. There is a limited bus service; 4 buses each way with the last one travelling at around 6pm. Therefore, a car is really needed for you to tour around the Island.

Ballamenagh is reached by turning left from the sea terminal following signs for Peel. After 8 miles you will reach traffic lights at Ballacraine, turn right following the TT course up through Glen Helen, along Cronk y Voddy straight then down the hill for just over 1 mile.

The drive is on the right before you go into Handleys Bends. There is plenty of room to park and turn the car around. Please let us know your estimated arrival time and we shall look out for you.

You can park at the rear of the property; however there is limited access for wheelchair users as the path narrows near to the doorway which is a standard width. There is a hallway then a flight of stairs leading to the first floor accommodation. Once upstairs everything is on one level, the bath is standard height and the shower is over the bath which would not be suitable for anyone with limited movement.

We do not have a loop system.

There is emergency lighting if the electricity trips.

We do not accept pets, however service animals are accepted. Service animals would need to be kept on a lead as the property has open gardens to the roadside, along with poultry and sheep in our grounds.
