

ROUTE (FROM BALLAUGH POST OFFICE)

- Head north east along Station Road.
- Pass Rowan Avenue on your left and take the next left onto the railway line.
- Follow the railway line west passing over a junction.
- At the 2nd junction at Bollyn Road turn right, walking up Bollyn road until the next Public Right of Way sign indicating a right turn back onto a public footpath.
- At this point go over the stile before following the enclosed footpath back until you are back at Station Road.
- Turn right at Station Road to return back to the Post Office.
