Cronkbane Cottages Accessibility Statement

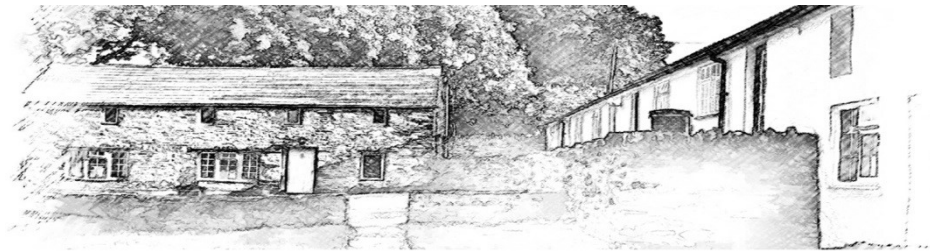
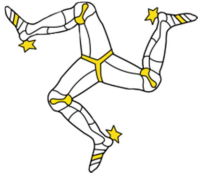
Cronkbane Cottages are located on the A3 (TT Mountain Course) at Cronk-y-Voddy. They are very accurately located on Google Maps and are easy to find. There are Mile Markers along the length of the TT Course and travelling from the Ferry terminal in Douglas or the airport at Ballasalla, you will end up following the TT Course, North towards Kirk Michael and Ramsey. You will see Mile Marker 10 as you come up out of Glen Helen and onto the Cronk-y-Voddy Straight. At the end of the Straight, the road bends to the right and downhill. 200 yards after the corner, you will see Mile Marker 11, on your left. Turn left, into the Cottages, 50 yards after the 11th Mile Marker. If you are coming from the North, you will see the "Welcome to Cronk-y-Voddy" sign post. You turn Right, into the property, 50 yards after this sign. Directions for the Cottages are on my Website and on the Airbnb site.

The Cottages are approximately 4.5 miles away from Peel City, where you can connect to all the main bus routes. There are supermarkets, restaurants, pubs, café's, bistro's, museums and of course Peel Castle and the harbour

Public Transport is not great for getting to Cronk-y-Voddy and I always recommend that guests staying here have their own transport. There are limited buses during normal working days and on Saturdays, via the 5C and the 6C bus services. Three services going North and three services going South. There are no buses on Sundays and Bank Holidays. Bus timetables and routes can be found on the internet.

The Cottages were built in the mid 18th century, on the side of the hills overlooking Kirk Michael and the North of the Island. There is a private car parking area, immediately in front of the Cottages. Regrettably, the slopes around the property, steps to negotiate and narrow entrances and internal doors makes them unsuitable for wheelchair users.

Pets are welcome visitors in 5 of the 6 Cottages and service animals in all of them. There is a large fenced and gated field at the side of the main house for dog walking and so on as well as gardens to the front and rear.
