SHORT ROUTE (FROM THE LANGNESS CAR PARK A)

- Take the central path from the car park that heads towards the lighthouse.
- At the end of the track just before the lighthouse turn left and then left again at the next junction to come back towards to the car park.
- When you reach the Herring Tower, turn left on the well-defined path back to the car park.

LONG ROUTE (FROM THE DERBYHAVEN ROAD CAR PARK B)

- Head east along the coast road from the car park, with the coast on your right hand side.
- Follow the Raad ny Foillan signs around the headland passing the Langness Lighthouse and then the Herring Tower on your left.
- Once you reach the old Castletown Golf Links Hotel follow the Fort Island Road back towards Derbyhaven.
- You will pass a set of ruins on your left before Derbyhaven, turn left here and follow the path across the golf course bringing you back to your original route along the shore and back to the car park.

ACTIVITIES

- How many different species of sea bird can you count?
- Can you find the hidden Provider Stone? A carved stone memorial on the coast of Langness. In 1853 the Provider, a schooner bound from Liverpool to Glasgow carrying salt, was wrecked at Langness, the master and 3 crew members were lost. (Clue – it's east of the Herring Tower).
- Bug Hunt – the grassy, rocky and sandy landscapes of these areas have many hidden homes – can you find any of the bugs, beetles, spiders and ants that call this place home? Why not take a magnifying glass and take a look at these creepy crawlies up close.
