
Welcome

ð Level Access

Fisherman's Cottage is situated on Minorca Hill in the village of Laxey and the approach to the property is on a significant incline. **We do not have level access to the property.** There is a step up from the road to the front yard and a further two steps up to enter the property. Inside there is a step down from the dining area to the lounge; and the property has a traditional cottage staircase leading to the first floor bedrooms and bathrooms. Access to the rear garden is also by a number of deep uneven steps.

The staircase is steep, narrow and twisted, and due to this the property is not suitable for wheelchair users. For this reason, it is also not suitable for anyone with limited mobility, the elderly or very young children.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Fisherman's Cottage by bus from the airport and the Sea Terminal.
- Take the number 3 Ramsey bound bus from the Lord Street Terminus in Douglas and alight at the stop at the top of Minorca Hill. It is about half a mile down a steep hill to the cottage.
- From the airport take any bus into Douglas and transfer to the number 3 bus towards Ramsey. Follow the instructions above.
