Garden Appartment, Castle View, 5 Marine Parade, Peel – Accessibility Statement

Introduction:

Our property is a garden appartment all on one level with fabulous sea views and views to the historic Peel castle from the courtyard. It has two spacious double bedrooms, two bathrooms, a spacious kitchen/dining room and a separate kitchen.

The property is excellently located for exploring the island, both North and South as well is being in a great spot for local walks over coastal hills.

Pre arrival:

Detailed directions, access and check-in information will be sent to you seperately after booking.

Getting to the property:

The appartment is situated in a Victorian red brick former boarding house which is located right on the sea front in Peel. The building is called Castleview and there is a name stone visible between the ground and first floor. The appartment is the garden appartment, which is accessed from underneath the steps on the left through the front courtyard.

There are several parking space immediately out the front of the property on a first come first serve basis. If these are taken there is more parking available further down the promenade in both directions.

If you are using public transport, there is a regular bus service that runs to Peel from Douglas, as well as services that run to/from the North and South of the island. The Sea Terminal is in Douglas, which is 20-25mins away. Ronaldsway Airport is in the South, near Castletown. Taxis can be taken to/from both.

Entering the property:

There are a few steps from the courtyard down to the front door. There is a front light but in case this has been turned off, please be careful – the steps start just past the meter cupboard on your left. Unfortunately, there is no ramp for wheelchair users and the doors are only standard width.

Getting around:

Once inside, the property is all on one level. However, if you wish to hang laundry out on the washing line in the rear courtyard, this is up a number of steep steps. This is accessed through the rear door through the kitchen.

The promenade (Marine Parade) itself is a flat walk all the way to the historic castle ruins, harbour, and marina. Either of these is gentle 10min walk away. From here you are only a couple of minutes from the town centre of Peel, which will involve walking up a gentle hill.

There is a large supermarket a short drive away and the town centre has two smaller supermarkets. There are also various takeaway options that deliver if needed but are otherwise within walking distance.

Bathroom Facilities:

There are two bathrooms inside – one ensuite in the first bedroom, which has a shower in a cubicle. The second bathroom is just before ethe second bedroom at the end of the corridor and has a bath with shower.

Additional information:

We allow dogs but please contact us in advance, so we are aware. Other pets aren't accepted I'm afraid.

There is strictly no smoking or vaping inside the property. Guests that do smoke are kindly asked to do so outside away from open doors or windows and to dispose of their cigarette buts appropriately.

If you have babies/toddlers that require a cot, please contact us as we may be able to provide one if desired.

The log burner in the living room is for decorative purposed only. It has not been commissioned so please do not attempt to use it.
