

JACKSON HOUSE ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT

LOCATION King William's College is situated in Castletown, the south of the Isle of Man. It is on

The A5 road to Douglas. Jackson House is a satellite building situated on the left hand side of the main school and is part of Music School. Visitors are required to use the main car park during their stay. The building does have limited disabled

access, please contact us for further details.

ENTRANCE

Access to the building is only through front door which has a code pad. The code will be given prior to arrival or you will be met by the Caretaker. The entrance would accommodate wheelchair access and all rooms and facilities are on the Ground floor.

GROUND

There is a modern kitchen and lounge on this floor together with 6 twin rooms which are all en-suit, there are 'walk-in' showers in each room so there is limited disabled access.

The live-in Caretaker who is on call will be available should assistance be required, guests will be met on arrival and showed to their rooms and given contact details and instructions regarding emergency procedures.

Jackson House is used by our boy boarders so is only available during the summer holiday period.

As we are a boarding school child protection and safeguarding is extremely important, unfortunately we are unable to offer catering during term time but there are suitable facilities available for meal preparation. Guests may be required to wear visitor lanyards whilst on school grounds.
