### ROUTE (FROM FENELLA BEACH CAR PARK)

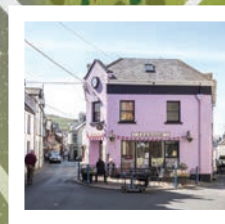
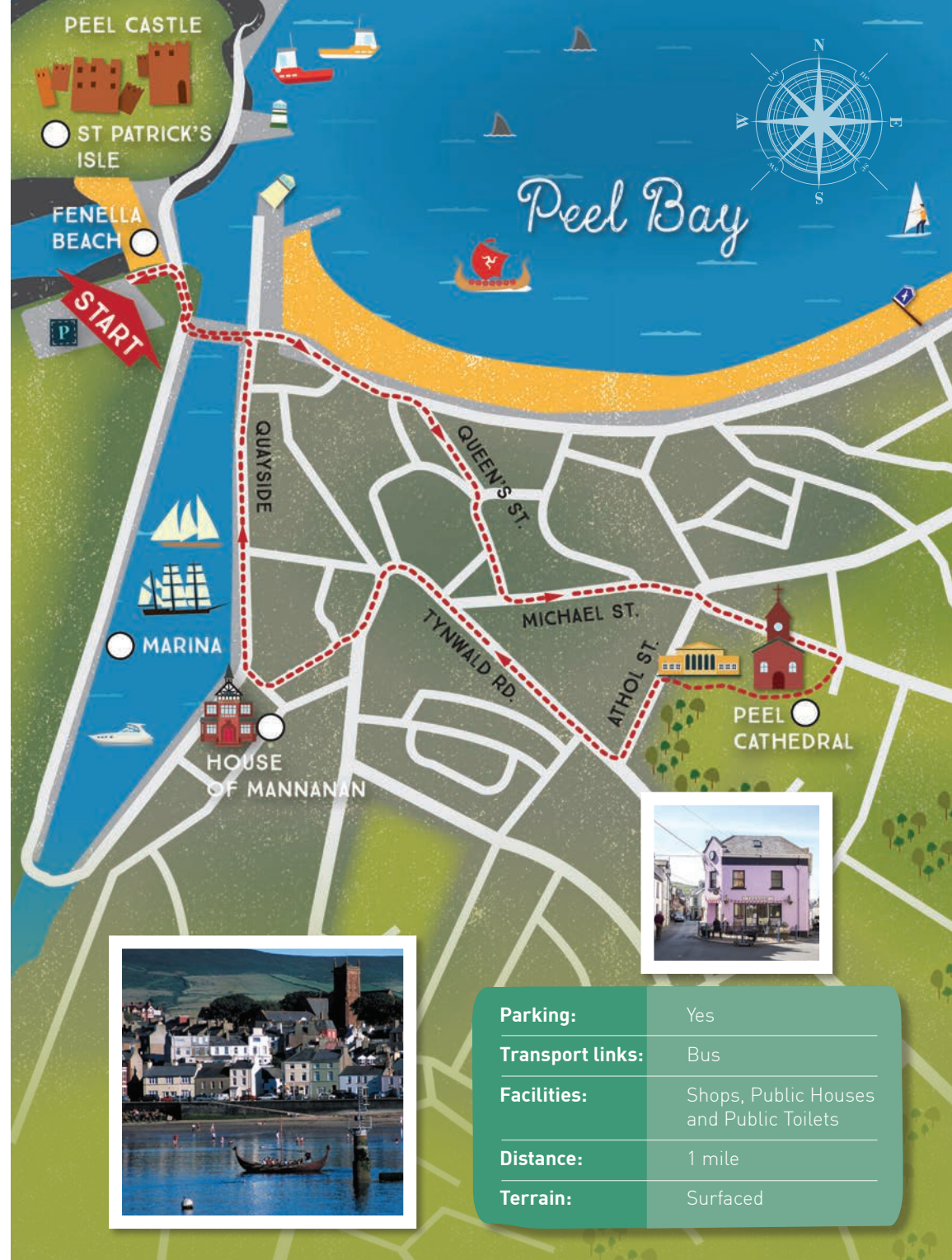
- Cross over the foot bridge and continue along the promenade with the sea on your left.
- Turn right up Queen's Street and continue straight through following up Orry's Lane.
- Turn left once you reach Michael Street and follow until you join the Derby Road.
- Enter the grounds of Peel Cathedral on your right and spend some time in the gardens.
- Leaving the rear entrance of the Cathedral ground onto Atholl Street.
- Turn left and join Douglas Street at the junction.
- Head down Douglas Street to the next junction and follow Castle Road down passed the old St Peter's Church.
- When you reach East Quay turn right and cross the bridge back to Fenella Beach.

### ACTIVITIES

- Why not collect some shells on Fenella beach before you leave – these are great for painting on. Can you find whole ones?
- While in the Cathedral gardens – can you identify the 4 folk lore tales? Can you identify the plants in the kitchen garden?
- In Cathedral Gardens, can you work out which Norse God is carved onto the back of the Celtic Crosses – clue, he had a pair of Ravens.

- Why not go for an ice cream and walk along the breakwater, looking out for the local seals.
- Why not walk around the outside of Peel castle, stopping to see if you can spot any sea life.
- Find a spot on the promenade and watch the sunset.
