## SHORT ROUTE (FROM WEST QUAY)

- At the swing bridge cross towards the north and follow the road to the right, joining Mooragh Promenade.
- Walk along the promenade and at the junction of Park Road, turn left and return back through Mooragh park passing the boating lake.
- Turn left at North Shore Road, then take the next right onto Old River Road
- Continue along Old River Road before the following the swing bridge back to West Quay.


## LONG ROUTE (FROM WEST QUAY)

- Cross the swing bridge north to Mooragh Promenade. Continue to the end of the Promenade and descend onto the beach.
- Continue along the beach northwards until you reach a set of timber framed steps on your left at Dog Mills.
- Climb the steps up and onto the Bride Road.
- Follow this road until you reach the junction with Mooragh Promenade road, turn left here.
- When you reach Park Road follow the path through Mooragh Park, passing the boating lake.
- Turn left at North Shore Road, then take the next right onto Old River Road.
- Continue along Old River Road before the following the swing bridge back to West Quay.

Pacific Oysters Features to look for Frilly Oval shell with an average length of
10 cm . Shell may have dark purple patches.


## Darwin's Barnacle

 Features to look for -$5-10 \mathrm{~mm}$ in diameter, White in colour with only 4 outer shell plates and low conical body.
