

# 1 RAMSEY NATURE RESERVE BEACH WALKS

## SHORT ROUTE (FROM WEST QUAY)

- At the swing bridge cross towards the north and follow the road to the right, joining Mooragh Promenade.
- Walk along the promenade and at the junction of Park Road, turn left and return back through Mooragh park passing the boating lake.
- Turn left at North Shore Road, then take the next right onto Old River Road.
- Continue along Old River Road before the following the swing bridge back to West Quay.

## LONG ROUTE (FROM WEST QUAY)

- Cross the swing bridge north to Mooragh Promenade. Continue to the end of the Promenade and descend onto the beach.
- Continue along the beach northwards until you reach a set of timber framed steps on your left at Dog Mills.
- Climb the steps up and onto the Bride Road.
- Follow this road until you reach the junction with Mooragh Promenade road, turn left here.
- When you reach Park Road follow the path through Mooragh Park, passing the boating lake.
- Turn left at North Shore Road, then take the next right onto Old River Road.
- Continue along Old River Road before the following the swing bridge back to West Quay.

## ACTIVITIES

- Why not try rock pooling around the stone piers? – Can you find any anemones, crabs or starfish?
- Would you like to take part in some citizen science? **Pacific Oysters**  
Features to look for - Frilly Oval shell with an average length of 10cm. Shell may have dark purple patches.



**Darwin's Barnacle**  
Features to look for - 5-10mm in diameter, White in colour with only 4 outer shell plates and low conical body.

<b>Parking:</b>	Yes
<b>Transport links:</b>	Bus / MER
<b>Facilities:</b>	Toilets / Café / Shops
<b>Distance:</b>	2 miles / 4.5 miles
<b>Terrain:</b>	Sand, shingle and/or surfaced
