Accessibility Statement – 1st January 2018

Raymond's Bed and Breakfast is set on Hutchinson Square which was first designed and built in 1888. The accommodation comprises of a guests lounge/dining area which is fully accessible from the ground floor. There are two steps into the front of the property and we have no ramp available for wheel chair access. The door is wide enough to accommodate the entrance of a wheel chair and access to the lounge/dining area is achievable. There are a total of 14 steps over two tiers that need to be climbed to access either bedroom on the first floor; we have no lift available due to the size of the accommodation and date that the property was built.

All bathroom facilities have been fitted with lever arch taps including the showers; the bath in Room 1 does only have a normal traditional tap.

The rooms have no steps inside them and a wheel chair can be used when in the rooms, if required.

Unfortunately we are unable to accommodate full time wheel chair users as we have no lift and have 14 steps to the bedrooms.
