

Outside the annex

The annex has access to a lovely sunny garden with garden furniture and BBQ. There is an outside toilet with running hot water.



Other information

There is ample clothes hangers/storage upstairs and an extra easy to assemble pull out bed if needed with privacy screens to turn into a family room. There are other electrical items such as a hairdryer, iron, ironing board etc plus change of cotton bed linen and beach towels. First Aid box in the living area. Changeover day is Saturday unless prior arrangement. For all booking arrangements, please refer to the booking form or contact owners.

There are guidebooks and maps in the lobby for you to use during your stay. Road cyclists or motorbike enthusiasts will find the immediate access to the TT course a joy. For Hikers, there are many countryside walks will take you up into the hills or to the Raad Ny Foillan coastal footpath.

Peak Times: Christmas & New Year, February half term, Easter, May Bank Holidays, TT Fortnight in May/June, Tynwald Day & Manx National Week, Southern 100 in July, and MGP in August. **Please note no bookings can be made during these times, unless agreed by the owners.**

Summer season is from May to October. Winter season is from 1st November to 30th April.

Reayrt Ny Marrey

Access Statement

Reayrt Ny Marrey is a self contained annex situated on the famous TT course in the heart of Kirk Michael village. It is in within walking distance of the beach, pub, chemist and local shops. It has its own clear visual entrances. The double patio doors open onto a front large step and the same level pathway via the side door. The accommodation is suited for one or two persons. We do not accept pets, however if you wish to bring your assistance dog, please contact us to discuss your requirements.



The site is steeped in history that goes back centuries and you can view the former Bishop's graves and see the remains of the old Keele (church) from the tiered back garden where it abuts the old graveyard. You can also see the preserved Celtic crosses on display in the current church, which is open from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm each day by using the foot-sty from the garden and walking through the graveyard, or take a short 200-yard walk up the village and go through the famous lychgate.



Inside the Annex- Ground Floor

The accommodation provided is compact but it is fully fitted for that home from home experience with everything that you would want in a self-catering holiday unit to cater for most needs. The annex offers you warmth, comfort, with onsite parking. The head height downstairs is standard and the living/eating area allows space to watch a movie on the internet TV or curl up with a good book and let Alexa find you some relaxing music. The living space has a fitted kitchen containing full size combo fridge/freezer, dishwasher, induction hob, and electric oven with overhead extractor fan. There is a small closed off boiler room with an easy to use top-loader washing machine and self-controlled combi-oil fired boiler (control instructions by boiler). The under floor heating is thematically controlled with a radiator and heated towel rail upstairs. There is a small table and chairs. Futon side chairs and a 46" internet TV with subscription channels included.



Inside the Annex- First Floor

The enclosed staircase leads from the lobby to the bedroom/en-suite shower room, which over looks the front living space with views of the opposite hills and the TT course. The room has low eaves with spacious built in furniture, medium size radiator, and a king-size bed with a medium firm mattress. Tall persons would require lowering their heads to move around to the window side of the room. There is some protection padding on the window eaves. The easy to open windows overlook the front of the property.



Shower Room

The built in shower cubic is large, glass panelled with an easy to adjust power shower with ambient lighting. The shower room also has built in storage and an integrated electric extractor fan on a timer. There is plenty of ventilation from two velux windows and a heated towel rail. The room is also sloped at the storage side and tall persons over 5'9 might find this space compromising but the hand basin, shower and toilet area are easily accessible.
