

Access Statement – Seafarer’s Cottage, 4 Douglas Street, Castletown

Details of the property including the contact details and address can be found on the Visit Isle of Man website and via a Seafarer’s Cottage website and Facebook page. Any changes in the availability of the property will be detailed on the website and Facebook page.

The property is located in central Castletown, facing the sea, and can be found using the road address. There is a name sign on the front of the property.



The property can be reached by public transport; it is approximately a 5 minute walk on flat terrain from the nearest bus stop and a 5-10 minute walk from the steam railway station.

Whilst there are not designated accessible parking bays, there is parking directly opposite the property which would be suitable for disabled visitors. Regrettably, the property is not suitable for wheelchair users due to the bathroom and bedrooms being located on the first floor. There is a small lip to the front door and a very slight step down into the cottage. There is no ramp available. There are also no handrails in the bathroom, and no pull cord for emergencies. The bath and shower must be stepped in to. It should be noted that some ceilings and door heads are slightly low as may be expected in an old cottage.
