Welcome

Tearmann is a beautiful 2 bedroomed traditional Manx cottage located in Castletown, the ancient capital of Isle of Man. It offers stunning sea views and spacious modern accommodation with large kitchen dining area, 2 reception rooms, a shower room and a further bathroom. Ideally located for easy access to the the town and its amenities within a 2 minute walk. a 10 minute drive from Ronaldsway airport and 20 minute drive to the ferry terminal in Douglas.

At a Glance

Level Access

- The main entrance has 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:

- Main lounge
- Snug

- There are steps from the main entrance to:
 - Bedroom
 - Terrace

- We have non-allergic bedding.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Tearmann by bus and boat or ferry.
- 2 minute walk to centre of Castletown square The bus stop is 0.01 miles / 3.2 km from Tearmann.
- The nearest port is Douglas. The port is 12 miles / 19.3 km from Tearmann.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- Drop off point is to the rear of the property over roof terrace. From the parking to the main entrance, there is 1 step. There is no ramp and no lift.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is 1 step. There is no ramp and no lift.

Main entrance

- The main door is side hung and manual.
- The door is 600mm wide.
- The main entrance has 1 steps.

Getting around inside



Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights and bedside lamps.
- Lights are traditional filament. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 12 steps.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- We have bathrooms with a bath and overhead shower.



Self catering kitchen

Main kitchen

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there are 2 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.



Lounge



Main lounge

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there is level access. The door is 600mm wide.

Snug

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 600mm wide, or more.
- The door is 600mm wide.

Terrace

Terrace

- To get to a table, there is 1 step.
- From the main entrance to the terrace, there are 14 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
