



Manx Whale and Dolphin Visitor's Centre Accessibility Statement

Location

Michael Street, Peel (the main high street)

1 minute walk from central bus station

Parking available in nearby public car parks or sea front. Parking is not allowed on the high street, but it can be used for pick up and drop off a majority of the time. The street is closed to cars Mon-Fri 11:00-13:30, Saturday 10:00-16:30.

Opening times

Usually open 10:00-16:00 Wednesday to Sunday. Hours are subject to change so a facebook post goes out every Sunday to inform of our opening hours for the week ahead.

Accessibility

The centre consists of one public room, so all areas are accessible. It is well lit and information boards are written in fairly large text. The toilet is located at the rear of the shop and is clearly signed, the doorway to the toilet is relatively small and wheelchair users would have to alight wheelchair before going in. There is room to change babies on the bathroom floor and there is a sink.
