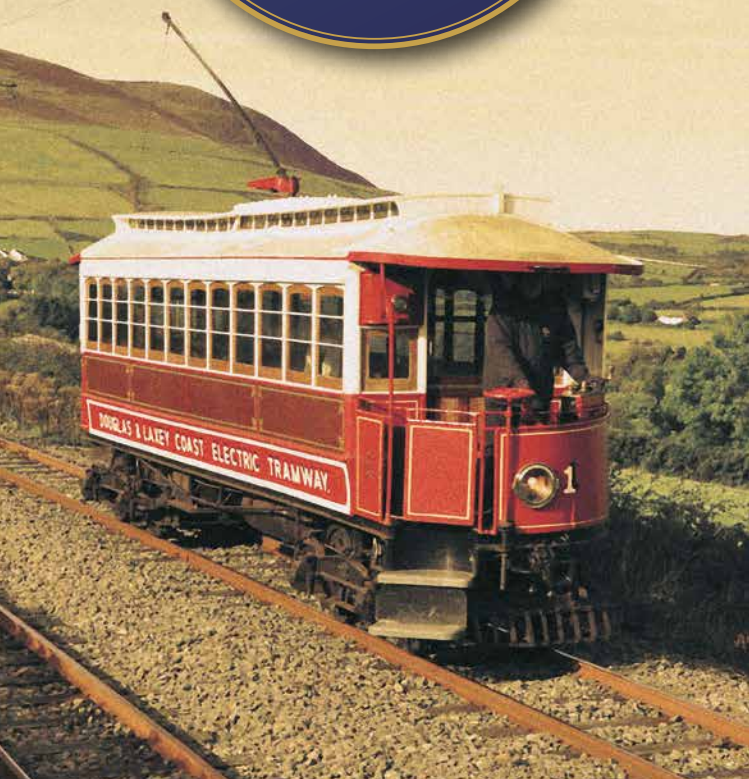

SUNDAY 2ND SEPTEMBER

TRAVELLING POST OFFICE

A special postal service will operate between Derby Castle and Laxey Station to mark the 125th anniversary of the Manx Electric Railway. New railway letter stamps were issued on 29th March 2018. Both stamps will bear an MER 125 overprint. The commemorative covers will be carried in Mail Van No.4 on the **09:30** service from Derby Castle arriving in Laxey for **10:00**. The Mail Van will be situated in Laxey Station siding alongside Mail Van No.16.

The Railway Letter Service is operated by Ramsey Philatelic Services and Isle of Man Railways in conjunction with the Isle of Man Post Office. A number of special commemorative covers will be available for this anniversary. Further information may be obtained from Ramsey Philatelic Services, 5 Windsor Road, Ramsey, Isle of Man, IM8 3EG. MER Covers £4.75 each.

LAUNCH OF RESTORED RATCHET CAR NO. 14

Following three years of intensive restoration by dedicated volunteers and staff at Derby Castle Workshops, Car 14 celebrates its 120th anniversary year with its formal return to service.

Director of Transport Services Ian Longworth will officially launch Car 14 at Derby Castle at **09:00**, followed by a reserved return trip to Laxey for the volunteers and staff involved in the restoration.

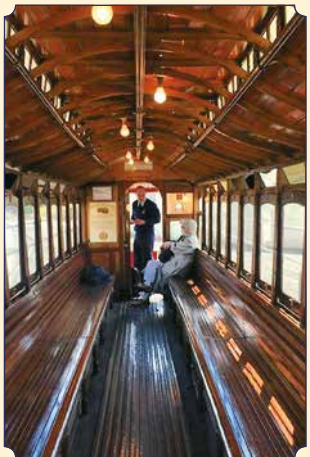

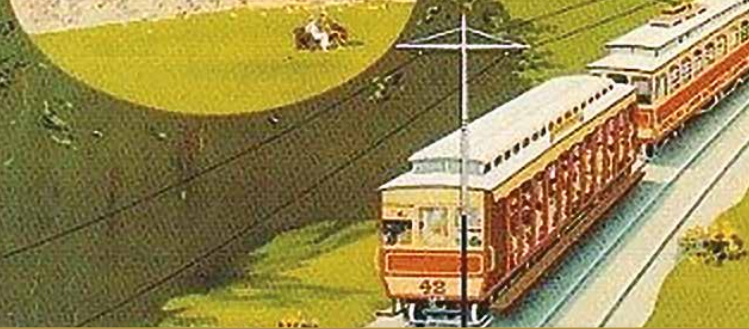
EVENING PARALLEL RUN WITH CARS 1 AND 2

MAIL TRAM RE-ENACTMENT

A typical 1970s era mail tram, consisting of a winter saloon, trailer and Mail Van 4, will re-enact a mail collection run between Ramsey and Douglas. For over 70 years, the MER collected mail from line side post boxes offering a vital service in the remote rural districts. This will be the first time since the mail service ended in 1975 that mail will be collected from the line



side post boxes. A serving postman from IOM Post will accompany the tram, with MER staff in period uniform offering numerous photographic opportunities.

The mail tram will depart from Ramsey at **13:50**.

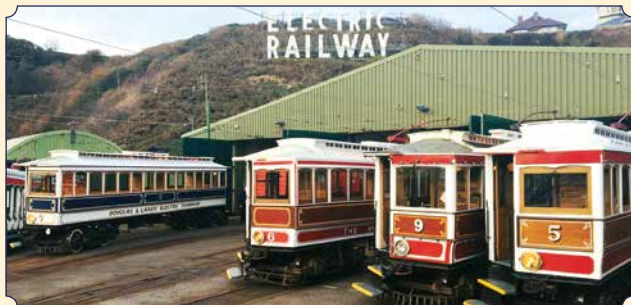
